- 3. Short topic Art Gorski: RSS news reader what is it and how to use. Art uses Apple News free version but frequently sees same articles, and going website to website is cumbersome. RSS came about to notify you when something new is on a website. Must use an RSS program to read current news. The process is anonymous so you cannot be identified. An RSS reader summarizes all the news articles you are interested in. Art uses the Reeder program (\$10) though there are many good free versions available on the Mac App Store.

Main topic Frank Croft: External Monitors: Choices, connections, power, heat, universal control, etc. Frank explained why people might want an external monitor: vision issues, video or photo editing, and running Windows on one monitor and Mac on another. Publishing programs often prefer a portrait monitor for projects. Connecting an external monitor requires more RAM. All M series Macs support at least one external monitor. Refresh rate on Intel Macs to M series Macs goes up to 240 Hz. Frank reviewed all the requirements to attach an external monitor. Discussed video outputs on

Mac and video inputs on external monitor. You must use the correct cable to connect a Mac to an external monitor. He discussed using a powered versus non-powered hub. HDMI carries data only; Thunderbolt carries data and power.
